More Timeline for the GPS

1985 – Jo Lord headed memorial flower barrel committee. Barbara Holbrook copied all early Baptist church records for GPS archives.

1986 – Set of colored slides of all roads in Galway was made. Inventory of Jersey Hill Cemetery by Mildred Hathaway.

1987 – GPS meetings were held in the Galway High School Library. "Galway Trunk" project initiated by Jean Schwarz and Arlene Rhodes, with Galway artifacts and program available for presentation to 4th grade classes when they study local history. Logo for GPS was designed by president, Herb Kopper. Joseph Henry Historical Marker erected. Mildred Hathaway copied 500 pages from journals of Galway Methodist church and Presbyterian churches found in safe at Galway United Methodist Church. She also copied letters written by Joseph Henry concerning Galway, from Letters of Joseph Henry Vol. 1 at Union College Library. Arlene Rhodes copied history of Galway in 1900s written by Ethel Robb.

1988 – Organized the Galway Village Sesquicentennial Celebration with Arlene Rhodes and Jo Lord co-chairs. Celebration held on Sat. May 21, 1988, with special stamp cancellation offered. Another set of salt-glazed pottery based on a Hudson-French design was commissioned from a Wisconsin potter for the Sesquicentennial.

1989 – Provisional charter granted by NYS Board of Regents.

1991 – Joined the Mohawk Valley Museums Consortium. Memorial flower barrels in the Village placed and maintained. Town Bicentennial committee formed, with Arlene Rhodes chairperson, June Michelfelder Secretary, Alice Bingham Treasurer; Jo Lord organized craft fair, Herb Kopper arranged for commemorative stamp. Bicentennial bumper stickers, tee shirts and stationery available for sale. Plans made to celebrate with a parade, art show, dramatic production, possible house tours, etc.
