Goal 1: Expand collaboration with the community

We will partner with local groups and district residents to develop and sustain opportunities and resources to benefit the community.

Provide meeting and community gathering spaces

- Promote public awareness of the availability of meeting and gathering spaces
- Make use of outdoor pavilion space after completion (See Goal 4)

Develop a stronger connection with Galway Central School

- Implement after-school drop-off at the library
- Offer tour/reception for groups: faculty, administration, School Board, PTSA, etc.

Increase Public Relations and Library Awareness

- Acknowledge the efforts of volunteers regularly
- Participate in events that promote awareness of community services
- Coordinate installation of library road (traffic) signs

Strengthen partnership with the Friends of the Galway Public Library

- Assist with planning and defining goals
- Review/update policies, roles, and relationship

Collaborate with other libraries

- Partner with other libraries to bring in special programs, authors, etc.
